	The registrar had received information that Dr. Nimmo had received a suspended jail sentence for insurance fraud in December 2015. This was a case brought forward by the UK Civil Aviation Authority.	
	Further investigation revealed that Dr. N had been struck off the GDC register in 1989 for serious professional misconduct. He had received a nine-month jail sentence in 1998 for practicing while struck off the register	
	<ul> <li>The GDC confirmed that he was struck off the register on 15th December 1989 after being found guilty of serious professional misconduct. Applications he made for restoration to the register in November 1995 and again in November 1996 were rejected. He is currently not registered to practice dentistry in the UK.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>At the time Dr. N applied for registration with the SMDC in 1999, he submitted a certificate of registration with GDC, knowing full well that he had been struck off the register. Dr. N's initial registration in1999 was therefore obtained by misrepresentation. He has been guilty of serious professional misconduct. His application for renewal has been refused. He has been informed accordingly. He has not appealed the decision.</li> </ul>	
3.0	Application of Dr. T from Sri Lanka	
	The Chair informed the council that an application from Dr. T from Sri Lanka had been initially refused based on the fact that he was not duly registered with the Sri Lanka Medical Council. His name had been struck off the register because he had not renewed his registration in 2006.	
	The applicant took remedial action and had his name reinstated on the register in Sri Lanka. He was thus registered with the SMDC.
